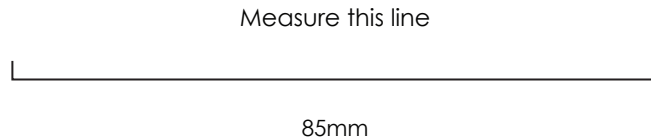


Get your sizing right

Here's how to measure your ring size

Note: Before printing this guide, make sure that you're printing on a standard A4 paper (210mm x 297mm) and that this guide is set to print at 100% scale. If you are unsure you can place a credit card on the guide below to check



Option 1: Using an existing ring

The easiest way to work out your ring size is to use an existing ring. To check your ring size, get an existing ring that fits on your finger you'd like to wear your payment ring and match the inside of the ring to one of the circles below. You should only be able to see the black circle inside of your ring and little to no white paper.

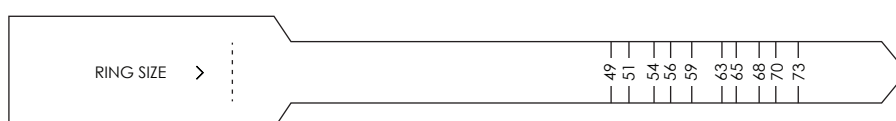


Option 2: Use a ring sizer

After you cut out the ring sizer, cut along the dotted line to create an opening. Wrap the sizer around your finger with the numbers facing outward. The number that appears closest to the opening is your ring size.

We recommend selecting a size that goes on and off with your finger easily, so try moving the sizer over your knuckle.

Note: Your ring size may vary slightly depending on the ring style and time of day. Check your ring size more than once at various times of the day to ensure the best fit.



If you'd like to be 100% sure on the size, we'd recommend you get your finger size measured at your local jewellers.
